

SUB: A – LEVEL PROFILE

Dear Student,

Thank you for enquiring about our A-Level programme which is being offered at Lahore Grammar School (55-Main, Gulberg) since 1997.

The Lahore Grammar School was established in 1979 and provides quality education to both boys and girls till A-Level. It is affiliated with the Cambridge Board of International Examinations for the GCE O- and A-Level programmes. Our students have been achieving outstanding results every year with a number of students being amongst the top achievers in the world as well as in Pakistan.

The important points related to the A-Level programme are as follows:

- * Registrations for the A-Level admissions commence in the second week of June, following the advertisement in the leading newspapers of Lahore. The last date for registration is usually **15th August**.
- * Students are required to opt for a **minimum of four subjects** from either Option 1 or Option 2 which can later be reduced to three subjects if the student is unable to cope with one of the subjects.

- * The following students are required to sit for a written test:
 - English General Test for students opting for subjects other than Sciences and not having an A- grade in O-Level English Language.
 - Applied ICT Test for students who have not done Computer Studies /or Applied ICT at O-Levels

- Urdu Test for students opting for ‘A-Level’ Urdu, but having second language Urdu in O-Levels.
 - Art and Design Test for all students.
 - Students who have done Pure Science i.e. Physics, Chemistry and Biology at O-Level and are opting for the same will not be required to take any written test. Their admission will depend on their O-Level grades.
- * The test is followed by an interview with the Principal. The final decision with regard to admission will therefore depend on the following factors:
- * Standard O-Level grades (Preferably A-C).
 - * Standard result in written tests.
 - * An acceptable grade in English Language and satisfactory communication skills in English as evident from the interview with the Principal.
- * Participation in co-curricular activities as well as extensive reading habits are also an important criteria for admission.
- * The A-Level prospectus for the session **2010—2011** will be available after **15th June** and can be collected from the school office. It will also specify the details of the fee structure for the A-Level programme.
